



**Medicine Bluff Studio was “Green” when “Green” was called
“Environmentally Friendly”!**

When we started our company it was our conscious effort then to be “environmentally friendly”!

We purchase clay that is produced in our area and we purchase all of our products as locally as possible. Our clay scraps are recycled for our reuse and the small amount remaining is donated to local art schools and studio artists whenever possible, hoping they will pass on the tradition. Reject tiles and over runs are donated to local mosaics classes for re-use.

We do not use lead glazes, and 95% of our glaze process is done with brushes by hand. We always fire as efficiently as possible using electric kilns keeping smoke and fumes from entering the environment. We use true handmade methods versus using automated processes - from rolling the out the clay by hand, to cutting it by hand, and pressing each tile on a handmade press that we’ve used from day one! Our tiles are air-dried naturally using fans only when necessary to circulate the air.

We always recycle our packaging and shipping boxes, as you will see in your shipments. We shred most of our paper documentation to reuse for packing.

Being a small company – “green” comes naturally!

Medicine Bluff Studio is a small quality driven art production studio who uses lean manufacturing methods taught to us by the state of Oklahoma where we started our business. As a result, we leave a very small carbon footprint.
