Tile Tip of the Month

Question: When I am purchasing tile, why do I have to buy more than I need?

Answer: Frustrating as it may be...including 10-15% overage on your orders will save you time and money when it comes time to install. Keep the following in mind:

- Some breakage in transport is expected and a tile or two has been known to break after arrival at the jobsite too.
- Depending on the intricacy of your installation, your installer may need several extra pieces for cuts, corners and mitering
- Many of our lines are made to order, which means that if you did not request enough on your original order you may need to wait 3-4 weeks for the manufacturer to produce those last 2 pieces you need for your installation
- Ordering extra enables you to be selective about the tiles you want to use, especially when it comes to stone.
- Last but not least....it’s important that you have leftover material that you can store in your garage or basement once the job is finished. You will be very happy to have it if you ever have to do a repair....you’ll have a matching replacement on hand!
